Role Description

Purpose:

The purpose of YPAC is to engage young professionals under the age of 40 in the process of fundraising and community outreach. These professionals assist us in reaching younger volunteers and are given an opportunity to gain non-profit development and board governance experience.

Goal:

Members will act as ambassadors for the Foundation, attend 3rd party events, join internal event committees, speaker's bureau and create relationships with companies for sponsorship.

Commitment:

- Each member will commit to at least two (2) years of participation with an opportunity to extend their participation for an additional two (2) years.
- Each Member will attend a minimum of 8 of the scheduled 12 monthly meetings.
- Each Member will make a personal financial gift to the Foundation.
- Each Member will actively engage in at least four of the fundraising events managed by YPAC.
- Each member, over their two-year term, connects the office staff with at least two companies to engage in sponsorship.
